'Alana's Laugh'

New

Medium. One of the two new hostas from Heuchera hybridizer Dan Heims from his hosta hybridizing program emphasizing purple pigments and white wax. This waxy blue hosta has nicely ruffled leaves with purple petioles and sometimes some blue in the leaf. The leaves are light and airy and hold their blue color well. It is a different look. **\$15.00**

'Buttonwood Bay'

GHF Introduction, New Introduction

Medium. Our new blue hosta reminds me of moving waves, continuously rolling west toward the sunset. Its very blue pointed leaves are tightly ruffled and laid out flat like the bay itself. Yes, Buttonwood Bay is a real place, down in the Florida Keys. **\$18.00**

'Effervescence'

New

Small. This bright yellow hosta from Dan Wols has great spring impact. As this hosta calls you to come closer you will appreciate the nice ruffling on its arching pointed leaves. A seedling of 'Marilyn Monroe' and 'Neptune', (where it gets its ruffling) and 'Designer Genes' (where it gets its yellow color). **\$14.00**

'Flash Freeze'

Exclusively for hosta clubs, First time introduction

Medium to Large. The powder blue leaves of this new introduction from Doug Beilstein are cupped and somewhat puckered and tend to overlap and wrap around their petioles. It is a welcoming upright hosta that reaches out to you palms up. It has a classic blue hosta look. **\$18.00**

'Gabriel's Wing'

Large. This is probably the best of the margined sports of 'Empress Wu'. Its huge blue leaves sport bright yellow margins in spring. It grows well and does best if given some bright light during the day. From Don Ralston, this hosta is a winner from winning lineage. **\$12.00**

'Gold Elation'

Special New Introduction

Very Large. This a great new hosta from hosta hybridizer Leslie Fraser, really great! This very giant hosta from 'Elatior' parentage has excellent yellow color and can tolerate some sun, especially in northern gardens. We have been very pleased by how well it has grown here in North Carolina, not burning for us even in the worst years and we think it will make an impact in your garden. **\$20.00**

'Jaws'

Medium. Yes, we are bringing back it back! 'Jaws' is not really a scary hosta although its green leaves do seem to have rows and rows of shark teeth. It makes a very well behaved clump in the garden especially if planted in half a day of sun. A "goodie" from Altera Scheer. **\$10.00**

'Little Devil'

Mini. For me this has become a classic miniature hosta because it keeps its small leaves as it quickly makes a dense, flat mound in the garden. It has a clean white margin that never disappoints. The perfect mini to give your new novice hosta friend. **\$8.00**

'Megan's Angel'

Very Large. This giant blue hosta with a bright yellow margin is a great landscape plant. From 'Blue Angel' it is easy to grow and very dependable. The masses of near white flowers in early summer even enhance its landscape appeal. One of the best very large, variegated hostas. **\$10.00**

'Silver Twist'

Small. The best part of a miniature hosta collection is that there is always room for one more, and you will certainly want to include this impressive cultivar from Japan introduced by Barry Yinger of Asiatica Nursery. From 'Tortifrons' heritage, these lance-shaped leaves are blue green with a silver gleam of white wax. The leaf margins are also moderated crinkled. **\$10.00**

'Sushi Bar'

Medium. This sport of a Japanese hosta has the classic look of its parent *H. longipes*. It has clean white margins on a shiny dark green leaf and wonderful purple flowers blooming in late summer that will surprise you with their rich purple scapes. I would buy this one just for the flowers. **\$14.00**

'Trophy Wife'

Very Large. I love hostas that jump out of the ground that are screaming yellow. New from Bob Fox, this hosta is not only a bright "spring yellow" it is a rare huge one. The sturdy rounded leaves are also ruffled with strong veins and yes, it does become greener in summer but that is what allows it to grow so big. **\$18.00**
