* GHF Introduction

- *‘Carolina Blue’** Medium. This is where it all began. A cross of ‘Halcyon’ and ‘Riptide’ this very waxy light blue hosta has purple petioles and great vigor. It makes a full mound that will catch your eye in the spring and make a Tar Heel proud. **\$8 each**
- ‘Golden Falls’** Very Large. A new large bright yellow seedling of ‘Niagara Falls’ from Doug Ruff has it all. It is an elegant combination of upright cascading long-pointed leaves, many deeply impressed veins flowing down, and tight ripples on the leaf edges. Even the large pale lavender flowers in summer are too pretty to remove early. A new classic **\$18**
- *‘Grape Fizz’** Large. Back by popular demand, this is one of my coolest hostas. It has leathery green leaves that are often irregular in shape. It grows very well making a mound quickly. But it is its beautiful large fragrant flowers with bright purple stripes that make it special. Hosta flowers are hot! **\$10**
- *‘Lemon Snap’** Medium. Our latest generation of bright yellow leaves with deep red on the petioles up into the leaf center, this one has round leaves that you can cup. Dark purple scapes appear in mid-summer with pretty purple striped flowers. This hosta was featured in the latest *Hosta Journal*, twice! **\$20**
- *‘Love of My Life’** Medium. I love this very special hosta. It is a cross of my ‘Sun Shower’ and ‘Designer Genes’ that sported right away from an all yellow plant to one with a green edge. Having *H. longipes* and *H. sieboldiana* genes, it has great spring color and is a robust plant right into fall. In addition, it also has red petioles and pinkish purple scapes. It is very sexy in the spring! **\$15**
- *‘Mouse Madness’** Mini. Yes, another mouse. This sport of ‘Blue Mouse Ears’ has bright white leaf margins in spring that will fade some in summer’s heat. But don’t be sad, it actually makes it grow like crazy. It is much more vigorous than many other mice. It sells with vigor, too. **\$15**
- ‘Peacock Feathers’** Medium. This blue hosta has nice heart-shaped leaves, good substance, and vigor. The flowers are what are really special, they have extra petals, 7-15 in a single corolla, and yes the pollen is viable! It is a special hosta for your special hybridizing customer to play with. **\$8**
- ‘Rowan My Boat’** Medium. This is another one of Doug Beilstein’s excellent very blue hostas with an unusual leaf shape. This medium to large hosta has puckered waxy blue leaves that are folded into petite kayaks. Named for his grandson it makes a dramatic conversation piece in any garden. **\$18**
- ‘Viking Ship’** Very Large. This tall blue-green hosta is a seedling of ‘Komodo Dragon’ with nice delicate ruffling on the leaf margins and a high vein count displaying its *H. montana* heritage. While it is a very pretty hosta, maybe I like it most for the name. **\$10**

‘ Hawaiian Luau ’ Small. Wide dark green margined narrow yellow leaves from ‘Pineapple Upsidedown Cake’. Tetraploid form probably. Very different.	\$8
*‘ Honey Bear ’ Large. Gold leaves with a dark green center. Fragrant flowers and fast grower.	\$12
*‘ Honey Pie ’ Large. Rapidly growing gold hosta that is ruffled and puckered. Fragrant flowers!	\$10
‘ Hovercraft ’ Medium. Very blue almost perfectly round leaves hover above the clump.	\$10
‘ Imperial Palace ’ Medium. Heart-shaped rich green leaves with a light yellow center. Grows well.	\$8
*‘ Infatuation ’ Medium. Very waxy long pointed blue leaves with cranberry-colored petioles.	\$12
‘ Jetstream ’ Medium. Waxy blue leaves become shiny in summer. Great color and growth rate.	\$8
*‘ Mango Salsa ’ Medium. Yellow wavy leaves with deep red petioles and scapes. Sun tolerant.	\$12
‘ Megan’s Angel ’ Huge. Blue pointed leaves with a wide creamy yellow margin. Nice flowers.	\$12
‘ Nate the Great ’ Large. Upright clump of blue green leaves that are cupped and puckered, vigorous.	\$10
