For the last several years we have been offering some of our best new hostas as liners. As our production grows, this year we are able to offer 50% more different cultivars than we did just a year ago. Many never before offered hostas will appear on our May list also. We will send you several availability lists of our Classic Hosta Liners™ this year with different delivery times.

The hostas on this January Availability are now dormant in the nursery and are ready to be shipped now or later in the spring as quantities allow. Please order early to avoid disappointment as some quantities are very limited.

The wholesale hosta market has seen the price for hosta liners fall to extreme lows in the past decade. While this has been good for the consumer, it has also resulted in the demise of two cutting edge liner producers of new hosta cultivars. I think many in our business have forgotten that hostas have value and that they are not inexpensive to produce. Our liner prices are generally one half or less than our bare root plants which in turn are less than half of their retail price. For Example: Our very popular ‘Fruit Loop’ is a \$5.00 liner, a \$12.00 bare root plant for a hosta that averages \$25.00 retail. Yes, **we do offer quantity discounts on all our hosta offerings**, just ask and we will be glad to work with you as best we can. We want this to be profitable for us all.

Classic Hosta Liners™ in 96 plug trays and the minimum order is only 12 per cultivar with a total minimum liner order of 48 plants.

* ‘Ambrosia’^{PPAF} Large. Large very frosty blue heart-shaped leaves with a light yellow center make this ‘Guacamole’ sport unique. Fragrant flowers too. **Special \$4.00 each**

‘Aphrodite’ Large. Doubled-flowered form of *H. plantaginea*. Light green, shiny, sun tolerant foliage and large double white flowers that are very fragrant. **Special \$3.00**

‘Appletini’ Small. Very shiny apple green heart-shaped leaves form a tight mound. Great color and grows well. **\$3.50**

* ‘Baby Blue Eyes’ Small. Tight flat mound of blue heart-shaped leaves. Very cute. A good contrast to ‘Blue Mouse Ears’ **\$3.75**

- ‘Baby Booties’ Mini. Bright white-margined mini with green heart-shaped leaves, rapidly makes a cute little clump. **\$3.50**
- ‘Banana Split’ Small. Almost perfect heart-shaped leaves with a wide shiny bright green margin and white leaf center. Add to that dark scapes and purple flowers in a tight mound. Truly a classic look. **NEW \$7.50**
- *‘Bear Necessities’ Large. This fragrant-flowered hosta sports large deep green leaves that are rounded and puckered giving that *H. sieboldiana* look. Grows very fast and looks beautiful late into the season. **NEW \$5.00**
- *‘Blue Perfection’ Large. Very waxy light blue leaves. A fast growing, sun tolerant, blue ‘Ambrosia’^{PPAF} sport with fragrant flowers. **\$3.25**

- *‘First Blush’^{PP28,920} Medium. Green leaves with red petioles and red margins, then entire leaf blushes purplish red. Our first red-leafed hosta is a true breakthrough! **\$12.00 each, 48+ \$10.00**
- *‘Frost Giant’ Very large. Upright stately clump of large pointed blue leaves with bright yellow margins. A very sturdy hosta destined for greatness. **\$4.50**
- ‘Frosted Mouse Ears’ Mini. Classic white-margined form of ‘Blue Mouse Ears’ becomes brighter as the summer progresses. **\$4.50**
- ‘Fruit Cup’ Mini. Interesting new green cupped and puckered very round leaves that make a flat, tight clump. Very different and popular last year. **\$4.50**
- ‘Fruit Loop’ Mini. Dark green cupped and puckered round leaves with a very showy white margin. Makes a tight clump of symmetric foliage. A great new hosta! **\$5.00**
- ‘Gemstone’ Small. Small blue heart-shaped leaves that form a very tight mound. Good color and rapid growth. **\$3.00**
- *‘Heather Hill’ Small. Shiny bright green heart-shaped leaves with clean white margins. Leaves have good substance and color. **Special \$3.00**

- *‘**Honey Bear**’ Large. Dark green-centered sport of ‘Honey Pie’ with the same fragrant flowers and fast growth rate. A beautiful color combination. **\$4.50**
- *‘**Honey Pie**’ Large. Large heart-shaped shiny gold leaves that become with age. Rapid growth rate and fragrant flowers, too. A solid hosta in the landscape. **\$3.50**
- ‘**Hovercraft**’ Medium. Very blue almost perfectly round leaves hover above a spreading clump. Attractive even as a small plant. **\$4.00**
- ‘**Imperial Palace**’ Medium-large. Heart-shaped leaves have a yellow to cream center, and a wide green margin. Grows easily into an impressive clump. **\$4.00**
- *‘**Infatuation**’ Medium. This upright fountaining hosta has very waxy long pointed blue leaves with cranberry-colored petioles. *H. kikutii* heritage. **Special \$4.00**
- ‘**Itsy Bitsy Spider**’ Mini. This very small very narrow leafed blue-green hosta makes a very flat mat of wolf spider foliage. The perfect unique trough hosta. **\$4.50**
- ‘**Jet Black**’ Large. Very waxy blue heart-shaped leaves rapidly form a large impressive clump. Nice proportioned flowers, too. Holds blue color well. **\$4.50**

- *‘**Lemon Zinger**’ Mini. Our green-margined sport of the bright yellow ‘Dragon Tails’ quickly makes a clump of feathery foliage. A true mini. **\$5.00**
- ‘**Lemontini**’ Small. Almost perfect heart-shaped leaves emerge bright yellow and become chartreuse. Unbeatable in early spring. **\$4.00**
- *‘**Love of My Life**’ Medium. A very special hosta. Bright yellow leaves with bright green margins in spring with pink petioles and later scapes with pinkish bracts. **NEW \$7.50**
- ‘**Millennium**’ Huge. Large rounded very dark blue-green leaves form a wide spreading mound eight or more feet wide. Classic hosta that grows well almost everywhere. **\$4.25**
- ‘**Miracle Lemony**’ Small to medium. This wavy-leafed green hosta of *H. tsushimensis* parentage is the first yellow flowered hosta to be introduced. Very cool! **Special \$4.00**
- *‘**Orange Marmalade**’^{PP16,742} Medium. Blue leaves with a leaf center that lightens as the season progresses from yellow to orange, yes orange, to near white. **\$4.50**
- ‘**Peek-a-boo Purple**’ Medium. Long narrow waxy blue-green leaves with wide rich purple petioles forming a flowing open clump with purple scapes, too. Grows fast. **NEW \$7.50**
- ‘**Permafrost**’ Medium. Very colorful rich blue perfectly heart-shaped leaves with wide yellow margins. Very beautiful sport of ‘First Frost’. **\$5.00**

- ‘Picasso’ Small. Beautiful blue narrow leaves with a yellow margin make this hosta perfect for a container with other minis. Sport of Sayory’s ‘Indigo’. **\$5.00**
- ‘Pixie Vamp’ Mini. This very showy mini has wide white margins on its green heart-shaped leaves. Will brighten up any container. **\$4.50**
- ‘Poseidon’ Large. Drop dead pure white-margined sport of a doubled flowered *H. plantaginea*. The flowers are great but the foliage steals the show. **\$4.50**
- ‘Road Rage’ Medium. Variable green leaves that are puckered but have extra ridges that protrude upward in an irregular way creating a strangely contorted look. Yes, weird! **NEW \$7.50**
- *‘Tiny Bubbles’ Mini. Feathery bright gold undulating narrow leaves form a rapidly growing fountaining clump. Flowers are closed to add extra interest. **\$3.75**
- *‘Tom Terrific’ Large. Our first large yellow hosta with rich purple petioles. The round, puckered leaves with good substance become more yellow as the season progresses. **NEW \$7.50**
- *‘Twist Tie’ Small. Small very twisted upright blue leaves that have very good substance. One of the last to go dormant it is great as contrast in a bowl of minis. A favorite. **\$5.00**
- ‘Wonderful’ Mini. Very flat teardrop shaped yellow leaves form a symmetric miniature mound. Well-proportioned flowers make this a true mini. **\$3.75**
- ‘World Cup’ Large. Very upright gold round leaves that are extremely cupped and held horizontally. AHGA Hosta of the Year in 2018. A must have hosta! **\$4.50**
- ‘X-cellent’ Small-Medium. Beautiful wide green margins and strong yellow leaf center that will become white in more light. Very bright color and grows well. Excellent. **NEW \$6.00**
